- Fri, July 8** **DEADLINE (5:00 p.m.) to file to run for elected office, submission of a Candidate Affidavit to run for elective office, the form Appointing Campaign Treasurer, the Financial Disclosure Statement, and the first Report of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures.**
- Mon. July 11** **DEADLINE (4:30 p.m.)** for registering to vote with Prince George’s County Board of Elections located at 1100 Mercantile Lane, Suite 115A, Largo, MD 20774. You must be a resident of the City of New Carrollton and be registered to vote in order to run for office or to vote in the General Election.
- Mon. August 1** **DEADLINE (12:00 Noon)** for filing of Second Report of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures.
- Fri. August 5** **DEADLINE (5:00 p.m.)** for submitting an application for an absentee ballot.
- Wed. August 10** **ELECTION DAY – 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.,** New Carrollton Municipal Center.
- Wed. August 10** **DEADLINE (8:00 p.m.)** for receipt of absentee ballots (mailed or delivered) by the Board of Elections at the Office of the City Administrative Officer, New Carrollton Municipal Center.
- Mon. August 15** **DEADLINE (12:00 Noon)** for filing of Third Report of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures.
- Wed. August 17** **SWEARING-IN** of newly elected officials – 7:00 p.m., City Council Meeting, New Carrollton Municipal Center.

- Online** You can register online at elections.state.md.us if you have a Maryland driver’s license or MVA ID card.
