July 11 **DEADLINE (4:30 p.m.)** for registering to vote with Prince George's County Board of Elections located at 1100 Mercantile Lane, Suite 115A, Largo, MD 20774. You must be a resident of the City of New Carrollton and be registered to vote in order to run for office or to vote in the General Election. Mon. August 1 **DEADLINE (12:00 Noon)** for filing of Second Report of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures. Fri. August 5 **DEADLINE** (5:00 p.m.) for submitting an application for an absentee ballot. Wed. August 10 **ELECTION DAY – 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**, New Carrollton Municipal Center. **DEADLINE (8:00 p.m.)** for receipt of absentee ballots (mailed or delivered) Wed. August 10 by the Board of Elections at the Office of the City Administrative Officer, New Carrollton Municipal Center. Mon. August 15 **DEADLINE (12:00 Noon)** for filing of Third Report of Campaign Contributions and Expenditures. Wed. August 17 **SWEARING-IN** of newly elected officials – 7:00 p.m., City Council Meeting, New Carrollton Municipal Center.
