Protect Your Home When You're Away

Summer is a prime time for break-ins. In fact, July and August are the worst months for burglaries, according to the Insurance Information Institute. So before hitting the road, here are some suggestions to help keep you safe while you're gone.

Set your home security system before leaving.

If you don't have a system, consider investing in one. In addition to helping protect your home, it might earn you a discount on your homeowners insurance.

Stop your newspapers and mail.

Nothing says "homeowner on vacation" more clearly than piles of newspapers on the step, and magazines and letters bulging through the mailbox.

Trim trees and shrubs near doors and windows.

Make it difficult for would-be thieves to hide near your home.

Keep your lawn mowed.

Arrange to keep your grass cut, so it appears someone is home.

Let your neighbors know you're gone.

Provide a number where you can be reached. You might also want to leave a spare house key with someone you trust.

Put timers on your lights.

It's best if you can set the lights to go on at different times.

Put a password on your computer.

These days, burglars don't just break in to steal a television; many of them are sophisticated enough to hack your computer and gain access to your financial accounts. Before going on vacation, you may want to disable your automatic login and put a password on your system for when your computer is turned on.

Participate in NCPD vacation notice, by helping secure your home, you'll enjoy your vacation even more.

*DEPARTMENT OF CODE ENFORCEMENT***IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN WHEN EVERYBODY SEEMS TO WANT TO BE OUTDOORS.**

The Mosquito Control Program got underway starting in April. The Maryland Department of Agriculture initiated applications of larvicide Throughout the City, and that will continue all summer. They will proceed to put down traps in various parts of the City to determine if there is any indication of an infestation.

If necessary, they will spray for mosquitoes, but not without notifying the residents first. The spraying would be done on Thursday evenings only.

Stagnant water breeds mosquitoes and pests wherever it may be: in bird baths, pet dishes, pools, ponds, old tires, up turned trash lids and cans, to name a few. Please check your yard for any standing water. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Non-compliance on the part of property owners can lead to fines starting at \$1,000 and up to \$5,000.

Note:In the case of a foreclosure, the department has the right to go on the property and treat it for mosquitoes and, likewise, fine the responsible parties, including banks and other financial institutions.

People enjoy having outdoors/indoors events that bring a lot of people to their house or neighborhood, now that summer is here.

The City of New Carrollton would like to remind you that there are some regulations that must be observed and will be enforced.

1. If you are planning a special event or party that will impact the community, please call the City of New Carrollton at [301-459-6100](tel:301-459-6100) to advise of the date and time.
2. Noise - Please be aware that any audible noise emanating from your property or vehicle that is disturbing the peace, quiet and comfort of the neighborhood or residential areas that is audible at a distance of fifty (50) feet from the building, structure or vehicle in which it is located is prohibited between the hours of 11.00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. the next day is a violation.
3. Parking - No person shall stand or park a vehicle on any parking space on public or private property which is designated as reserved parking unless the vehicle displays a special registration plate or permit.
4. No person shall stand or park a vehicle on any private property without the owner's authorization. Entrances shall not be blocked; all vehicles shall be parked at least five (5) feet from the driveway entrance.
5. Trash - appropriate containers shall be placed in strategic locations to dispose of trash and debris in an appropriate. Empty bottles, cans and others shall be placed in containers and not on grass, curbs, sidewalks, under vehicles, etc.

It's a fun time of year so let's not spoil it by our neglect. Let's be good neighbors by being considerate of others and exercising common sense, and have a great summer!

- Narrow-neck containers with code identification numbers 1 through 7
- Wide-mouth containers such as peanut butter, yogurt, cottage cheese, sour cream, mayonnaise and whipped topping; margarine/butter tubs; and
- Prescription bottles
- Coat hangers
