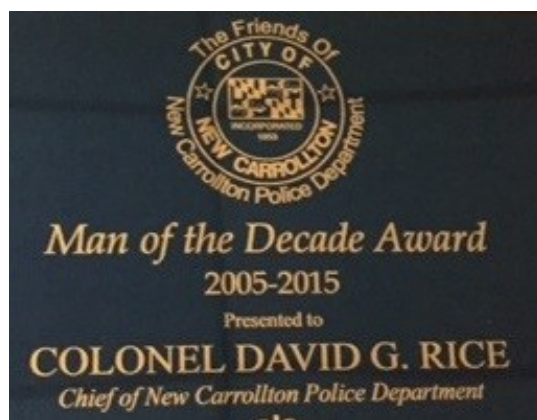

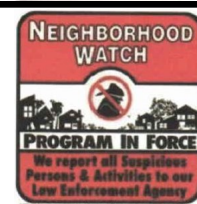

**Attention City Residents!** There have been several incidents of dumping in front of the Public Works Yard in recent months. The Department of Public Works would like to remind citizens that dumping is prohibited, and punishable by a fine. The Department of Public Works facility, and the surrounding area is under video surveillance and any violators will be prosecuted accordingly.



The City of New Carrollton offers the citizens a place to dispose of used motor oil and antifreeze. At the DPW facility there is

a tank designated for used oil and antifreeze. Citizens must dispose of the use-oil into the tank and place used containers in the designated recycling bin. If you have any questions please contact the Department of Public Works at **301-577-1008**.

## Department of Code Enforcement

The Code Enforcement Department responds to inspection requests for all rental properties to ensure minimum code compliance per the 2015 International Property Maintenance Code and the requirements are met for the Maryland's Lead Risk Reduction Act.

### IMPORTANT CHANGES TO MARYLAND'S LEAD RISK REDUCTION IN HOUSING ACT

1. Effective January 1, 2015 all residential rental properties built prior to 1987 must be registered with the Maryland Department of the Environment. These properties must undergo lead inspection in addition to your annual city inspection.

2. The state registration fee is \$30.00 per unit

3. City rental license will not be issued until all compliance requirements are met and properties are registered with the state.
