**FISCAL YEAR 2017
(July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017)**

The City of New Carrollton believes that supporting community activities enhances the community as a whole. In support of that belief, the City Council established a Youth Activities Grant for Fiscal Year 2017 (FY 2017). The grant provides reimbursement of eligible expenses to organizations that wish to hold programs (educational/sports). These programs must be open to residents within the corporate boundaries of the City of New Carrollton and promote enhanced community engagement. The maximum Youth Activities Grant award per organization for Fiscal Year 2017 will be \$2,500. Fiscal Year 2017 commences July 1, 2016 and concludes on June 30, 2017. All grant funds must be expended in FY 2017.

Please Remember Your Responsibilities



§ 100-12 Responsibilities of property owners and tenants:

A: It shall be the duty of every person, partnership, firm or corporation, whether as tenant, occupant or property owner, having control of any building or parcel of land abutting on a paved public sidewalk, to remove and clear away or cause to be removed and cleared away any snow or sleet from the portion of the public sidewalk which abuts on said building or parcel of land within 24 hours after the ceasing to fall of any such snow or sleet.

(1): Should the owner or person responsible for the maintenance of the property fail to remove the snow or sleet from the abutting sidewalk within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any snow or sleet event, the City shall have the right to remove such snow or sleet from the sidewalk. The owner or person responsible for the maintenance of the property shall bear the cost of removal. After thirty (30) days from the issuance of an invoice, any abatement costs that remain unpaid shall be recorded as a lien against the property and collected by entering same on the tax records of such property.

- Vehicle Repairs: 4 Violations (All have been closed)
- Vehicles on Lawn: 10 Violations (All have been closed)
- Outside Storage: 2 Violations (All have been closed)

Drive Safely as it gets Darker Earlier

Daylight Saving Time ends every year on the first Sunday in November. This means it gets darker earlier.

Darkness: When it's dark outside, depth perception, color recognition and peripheral vision are compromised. And the glare of headlights from an oncoming vehicle can literally blind a driver temporarily.

Even with high-beam headlights on, visibility is limited to about 500 feet (250 feet for normal headlights) creating less time to react to something in the road – especially when driving at higher speeds.

What should you do to combat darkness?

Aim your headlights correctly:

- Dim your dashboard
- Look away from oncoming lights
- If you wear glasses, make sure they're anti-reflective
- Clean the windshield to eliminate streaks
- Slow down to compensate for limited visibility and reduced stopping time

Compromised Night Vision:

Night vision is the ability to see well in low-light conditions. As we age, we have greater difficulty seeing at night. A 50-year-old driver may need twice as much light to see as well as a 30-year-old. At age 60 and older, driving can become even more difficult, according to the American Optometric Association. Some older drivers also may have compromised vision due to cataracts and degenerative eye diseases.

The American Osteopathic Association (AOA) recommends older drivers:

- Have annual vision exams
- Reduce speed
- Take a driving course; even experienced drivers can benefit from a refresher course, as some of the rules may have changed
- Minimize distractions at night, like talking with passengers or listening to the radio
- Check with your doctor about side effects of prescription drugs
- Be honest about your ability to drive after dark and limit driving to daytime hours if necessary.

Stay Alert, Stay Alive

While we do only one quarter of our driving at night, 50 percent of traffic deaths happen at night. It doesn't matter whether the road is familiar or not, driving at night is always more dangerous.

About 35,500 people were killed in car crashes in 2013, according to *Injury Facts 2015*. By taking some extra precautions, we can all contribute to reducing these numbers.
