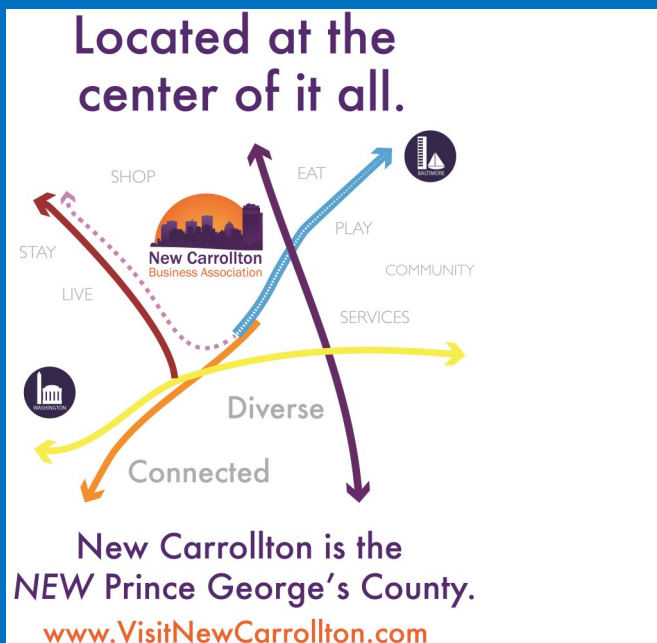

### SNOW PLOWING

### Be Prepared for the Snow and Wintry Weather!

**§100-12:** It shall be the duty of every person, partnership, firm or corporation, whether as a tenant, occupant or property owner, having control of any building or parcel of land abutting on a paved public sidewalk, to remove and clear away or cause to be removed and cleared away any snow or sleet from the portion of the public sidewalk which abuts on said building or parcel of land within 24 hours... after the ceasing to fall of any such snow or sleet.

**(1):** Should the owner or person responsible for the maintenance of the property fail to remove the snow or sleet from the abutting sidewalk within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any snow or sleet event, the City shall have the right to remove such snow or sleet from the sidewalk. The owner or person responsible for the maintenance of the property shall bear the cost of removal. After thirty (30) days from the issuance of an invoice, any abatement costs that remain unpaid shall be recorded as a lien against the property and collected by entering same on the tax records of such property.

### A Flurry of Snowflakes

If you noticed all of the beautiful snowflakes hanging in the City of New Carrollton Municipal Center – Multipurpose Room, they were hand crocheted, and hung up for the holidays and will be there thru January 2016 for all to enjoy.

Snowflakes are an iconic symbol of winter, and very beautifully displayed during the holidays and winter months. Here are a few unknown facts about snowflakes:

- Snowflakes are formed by snow crystals from in the clouds when the temperature is under the freezing point. They are created by water droplets freezing on small ice particles. As an ice crystal drops through the clouds it bumps and knocks others and becomes a snowflake.
- What do snowflakes look like? Amazingly snowflakes always have six sides and are similar to human finger prints, it is thought that no two are exactly alike. Both the form, shape and size of a snowflake depends on the temperature and moisture content of the cloud.
- Snowflakes can be categorized into six main types: Hexagon Plates (6-sided-flat shape with a star in the middle); Stellar Plates and Dendrites (most common, basic star shape); Needles (can be solid or hollow); Columns (6-sided, can be short/squat or long/thin, sometimes they have a cap); Bullets (column-shaped flakes tapered at one end to look like a bullet); Irregular Shapes (most snowflakes are imperfect, have grown unevenly, broken, melted, refrozen or reattached to other flakes).
- When it is extremely cold, and the snow is very fine and powdery the snowflakes become quite simple in design (needle or rod shaped).
- It takes about 200 ice crystals to make a Snowflake.
- The world's largest ever Snowflake to date found was 38 centimeters wide and 20 centimeters thick. This snowflake occurred at Fort Keogh, Montana, January 1887.
- On average Snowflakes fall from the sky at 3-4 miles per hour. Billions of Snowflakes fall in every snowstorm.
- Snowflakes are very lacy and light to the touch.
