



Be Prepared for the Snow and Wintry Weather!

§100-12: It shall be the duty of every person, partnership, firm or corporation, whether as a tenant, occupant or property owner, having control of any building or parcel of land abutting on a paved public sidewalk, to remove and clear away or cause to be removed and cleared away any snow or sleet from the portion of the public sidewalk which abuts on said building or parcel of land within 24 hours... after the ceasing to fall of any such snow or sleet.

(1): Should the owner or person responsible for the maintenance of the property fail to remove the snow or sleet from the abutting sidewalk within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any snow or sleet event, the City shall have the right to remove such snow or sleet from the sidewalk. The owner or person responsible for the maintenance of the property shall bear the cost of removal. After thirty (30) days from the issuance of an invoice, any abatement costs that remain unpaid shall be recorded as a lien against the property and collected by entering same on the tax records of such property.


