The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 19, 2017, in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Center by Chairman Sarah Potter Robbins. Attending were Chairman Sarah Potter Robbins, Vice Chair Lincoln Lashley, Councilmember Richard Bechtold, Councilmember Duane Rosenberg, and Mayor Andrew C. Hanko, Interim Administrative Officer Joseph Nagro, Director of Public Works Bernard Cochran, Treasurer Diane Dawes and City Clerk Doug Barber. Councilmember Katrina R. Dodro and Chief of Police David Rice were absent.
