

**CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON MINUTES

**3. EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 20-10 SUSPENSION OF THE 2020 CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON GENERAL ELECTION PROCESS**

**Motion:** Mr. Lashley moved that the Council adopt 20-10, an Emergency Ordinance of the City Council of New Carrollton authorizing the suspension of the 2020 City of New Carrollton General Election process. Ms. Robbins seconded the motion. The Council discussed the issue with City staff. City staff responded to questions of clarification posed by the Council on the issue. Chair Nembhard called for the vote. The motion was approved (5-0-0).

**Motion:** Mr. Peterson moved that the Council schedule a Special Council Workshop Meeting on Saturday, April 11, 2020, at the City Municipal Center (6016 Princess Garden Parkway Multipurpose Room) at 10:00 a.m. to discuss and review the FY 2021 Budget following all the requirements implemented by Governor Hogan. Mr. Lashley seconded the motion. The Council discussed the issue at length. City staff addressed comments and concerns given by the Council regarding obtaining the proposed FY 2021 budget material. Chair Nembhard called for the vote. The motion was approved (5-0-0).
