The Department of Public Works is currently working on or have completed the following:

- For the month of February, the Call A Bus Program transported riders to and from (79) medical appointments and errand runs
- The Sanitation department disposed of 272.70 tons of refuse and responded to 285 bulky item calls for the month of February
- City Horticulturist attended recertification training to keep the City's Pesticide Public Agency Permit and Professional Fertilizer Business License up to date.
- ARBOR DAY PREPARATIONS. (HANKO BUILDING/BECKETT FIELD): Prepared new picnic table area; installed steel edging, laid landscape fabric as weed barrier and installed 8" of playground mulch. Also added steel edging and soil/compost mix for flower bed area. An application has been submitted to Prince George's County for Beautification Award.
- **BECKETT FIELD ENTRANCE/ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING AREA:** Repaired landscaped area damaged by Pepco construction; removed soil off of plants, re-established steel edging, cut back ornamental grasses, weeded, fertilized newer plants and mulched. This garden is up for a 3rd year (2nd year sustainability) Prince George's County Beautification Award.
- **PLAYGROUND MULCH: 89th Tot Lot** Built up mulch to sliding board safety regulations (6" drop off from bottom of sliding board). Used 70 cu yd.
- **COMMUNITY GARDENS (Prepared for April 1st opening):** Cleaned out boxes, cleared fences and interior paths, rebuilt boxes that were in disrepair, added mulch to paths between boxes. The Route 450 Garden is up for a 4th year Prince George's County Beautification Award
- **SPRING CLEAN-UPS/MULCHING:** Pruned back perennials and select shrubs, cleaned up leaves and debris, weeded, edged and mulched plantings at City Hall, 85th Malls, Beckett Entrance, Hanko Building and the traditional red mulch at Bicentennial Hill.



CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON UPDATE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19)

The City of New Carrollton continues to prepare for and monitor the Covid-19 (coronavirus disease) outbreak. The City is following Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and state and county health department's guidance to ensure we are aware of the latest information and recommended action for our area.

As of March 12, 2020 there are 12 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Maryland, including four in Prince George's County. The CDC recommends that the general public continue to practice everyday actions (like washing hands often and staying home if sick) to prevent illness. For a full list of those actions, please visit www.cdc.gov/coronavirus.

Many City services like ticket payments, permits, applications, scheduling of special trash collections, and more can be done via our website (<u>www.newcarrolltonmd.gov</u>) or via phone (Administration: 301-459-6100 * Public Works: 301-577-1008 * Police: 301-459-0142). We encourage our residents to utilize those resources prior to visiting any City facility.

To help reduce the risk of transmission, the CDC has recommended social distancing measures including reducing activities particularly for those with increased risk of several illness. On March 12, 2020, Governor Larry Hogan issued an executive order prohibiting all events of more than 250 people. The safety of our residents and staff are our foremost concern. We regret to announce the cancellation of the following events, activities and services:

- Breakfast with the Chief (March 14);
- Arbor Day Event (April 1);
- Spring Festival (April 4);
- Public attendance at Council Meetings (March 16 & 18 & April 1)*;
- Rental of City facilities and use of City facilities for community meetings until further notice;
- Monthly City Board and Committee Meetings for the next 30 days or until further notice;
- Notary services until further notice;
- Code Enforcement inspections or re-inspections;
- Seniors Food Program (run by Prince George's County).

The City will hold its regular City Council Workshop Meetings on March 16 and April 1 and its City Council Legislative Meeting on March 18. All three meetings will be televised on our cable channels (Comcast 71 and Verizon 30), phone in comments allowed at the end of each meeting, and the videos will be posted on our website. The City will be **restricting visitors** from attending the public meetings to invited guests on the agenda only. This is both for the residents/visitors health and safety as well as that of our City Council, Mayor and staff.

- Parking enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of New Carrollton that a City of New Carrollton Veterans Memorial Citizens Advisory Committee is hereby created.

Whereas,	Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world, and
Whereas,	trees can reduce the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, lower our heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce oxygen and provide habitat for wildlife, and
Whereas,	trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires and countless other wood products, and
Whereas,	trees in our city increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community, and
Whereas,	trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal,

NOW, THEREFORE, I Duane H. Rosenberg, Mayor and the City Council, of the City of New Carrollton do hereby proclaim April 1, 2020 as Arbor Day in the City of New Carrollton, and urge all citizens to Celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands, and;

Ordinance 20-09 Budget Amendment Reconciliation No. Five: To Amend Ordinance 19-17, as amended Current Expense Budget for FY 2020

Effective: March 18, 2020

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF NEW CARROLLTON AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2020 AS EMBODIED IN ORDINANCE 19-17, AS AMENDED, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF TWO POLICE VEHICLES AND TO REFLECT MONEY BROUGHT INTO THE BUDGET FROM THE DESIGNATED PRIOR YEAR SURPLUS TO PAY FOR THE VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of New Carrollton (the "City Council"), a body politic and corporate of the State of Maryland is authorized to adopt a fiscal year budget, pursuant to City Charter, §C-14 "Budget and Finance"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a budget for FY 2020 via Ordinance No. 19-17, which was subsequently amended; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase two new police vehicles that were not provided for in the FY 2020 Budget; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for the acquisition of the police vehicles, money must be brought into the FY2020 Budget from City Designated Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amend the FY 2020 Amended Budget to provide for the purchase of two police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may, by a four-fifths vote, declare any proposed ordinance or any proposed amendment to an ordinance to be an "emergency" and shall thereupon be authorized to introduce and enact such ordinance or amendment at a single meeting; and

WHEREAS, an emergency ordinance shall become effective on the date specified in the ordinance, but no ordinance shall become effective until approved by the Mayor or passed over his veto by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has received prices for two new police vehicles that are currently available. If the City does not sign for the purchase of the vehicles as soon as possible, the City will lose the vehicles and have to wait until others become available at an acceptable price; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby declares that it is in the best interests of the City that this Ordinance be deemed an emergency ordinance so that it can be introduced and enacted at the same meeting and so that it can become effective immediately upon approval by the Mayor or when passed over his veto by the City Council.

Section 1. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of New Carrollton, that Ordinance 19-17, Current Expense Budget for the City of New Carrollton, Maryland for Fiscal Year 2020, under the heading of "City of New Carrollton FY 2020 Adopted Budget," as amended, be and hereby is amended as follows:
