Whereas, trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires and countless other wood products, and

Whereas, trees in our city increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community, and

Whereas, trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal,

NOW, THEREFORE, I Phelecia E. Nembhard, Mayor and the City Council, of the City of New Carrollton do hereby proclaim April 30, 2021, as Arbor Day in the City of New Carrollton, and urge all citizens to Celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands, and;

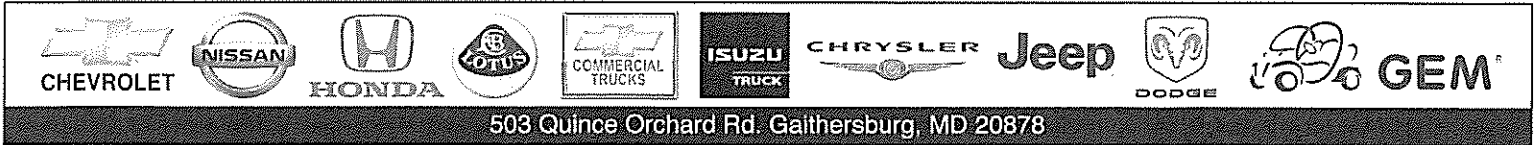
