# MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

### CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON

### **FEBRUARY 7, 1996**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council Meeting of the City of New Carrollton was held in the New Carrollton Municipal Center on Wednesday, February 7, 1996.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Chairman John A. Schaffer. Present were Mayor Andrew C. Hanko, Council Members Raymond J. Garvey, Rose M. Hurdle, Stephen L. Keleti, Public Works Director Richard E. Robbins, and City Administrative Officer Lawrence E. Pierce.

Council Member Sarah C. Potter and City Treasurer Duane H. Rosenberg were excused from the meeting.

#### 1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The City Council was lead in the Pledge of Allegiance by Girl Scout Members Colleen McCowan and Genieve Burgess and Cub Scout Member Matt McCowan.

#### 2. **REPORT OF THE MAYOR**

Mayor Hanko announced that Mr. Thomas Keely, Principal of Charles Carroll Middle School, was invited tonight to speak on behalf of his students test scores and his plans for the school. Also, Mayor Hanko congratulated Ms. Rise Gaines, Principal of Carrollton Elementary School, for receiving the 13th Annual Outstanding Educators Award. Ms. Gaines was nominated by Ms. Marie Smith and the Carrollton Elementary School Parent Teachers Organization. At this time Mayor Hanko invited Mr. Keely to the podium to speak on behalf of the program.

Mr. Keely thanked Mayor Hanko for giving him the opportunity to attend a City Council Meeting to discuss with the residents his plans to improve and enhance the quality of education provided at Charles Carroll Middle School. Mr. Keely personally thanked Mayor Hanko for partaking in the selection process of appointing him to serve as the Principal at Charles Carroll Middle School. Also, Mr. Keely thanked Mr. Robbins for clearing the school parking lot during the snow storm.

Mr. Keely began his presentation by thanking R&D Pet Store, located at the Carrollton Mall Shopping Center, for donating a 15 gallon fish tank to the school. Mr. Keely stated that the fish tank is placed in the front lobby of the school which serves as an incentive for students to attend school on a regular basis. The students are responsible for feeding the fish and cleaning the tank. Also, the Administration is offering to the teachers weekend trips for two at the Hilton Head Hotel in North Carolina. In order to explain the test results, a chart was displayed which showed a substantial increase of test scores in Reading, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Writing and Language Usage with a grand total increase of 62% from 1993 to 1995. Mr. Keely explained the Oasis Program which is designed to promote community involvement in an effort to improve student studies and organizational skills. Mr. Keely noted that Charles Carroll Middle School is the safest middle school in Prince George's County and acknowledged the Administration and school staff for their role in achieving this rating. Mr. Keely announced that Mrs. Susan Baudoin, who is the Home Economics Teacher at Charles Carroll Middle School was recently selected by the Maryland Association of Family and Consumer Sciences, as the 1996 Teacher of the Year. Mr. Keely welcomed questions from the Council.

Chairman Schaffer asked how the total percentage increase was determined. Mr. Keely replied that the scores were determined by performance outcomes of the students. Mr. Schaffer also asked if attendance is a problem at this school. Mr. Keely replied that the normal attendance is 94%. Charles Carroll Middle School is currently at 92% and the staff is striving for a 2% increase in attendance.

Council Member Keleti congratulated Mr. Keely for the percentage increase in student performance and asked for an explanation on how that increase was attained. Mr. Keely replied that packets were distributed to the students and it was mandated that the students study the information with their parents at home in addition to classroom instruction.

Council Member Hurdle asked how many New Carrollton students attend and students bused into the school. Mr. Keely replied that this year, there are 200 New Carrollton students and 500 students who live outside the New Carrollton area. Council Member Hurdle complimented Mr. Keely on the school newsletter and announced that the youth group called Colours will be holding a recital at Charles Carroll Middle School on February 23, 1996 at 7:00 p.m.

Council Member Garvey praised Mr. Keely on the school newsletter and the staff at Charles Middle School and was impressed with the safety rating. Mr. Garvey inquired as to the nature attributed to the safety rating. Mr. Keely responded that the safety rating is attributed to the dedication and devotion of the school staff. Chairman Schaffer asked if the school has incorporated a drug education and enforcement policy. Mr. Keely responded that the school offers the students classes coordinated by Ms. Marlene Cheney who is the health outreach coordinator to overcome drug addiction and usage. At this time, Ms. Cheney was introduced and spoke on behalf of the program.

Mr. Keely and Ms. Cheney were excused from the meeting and thanked for attending.

Mayor Hanko continued his report as follows:

Mayor Hanko held an unofficial meeting with the Administrative Officer and Major Teresa Chambers, District 1 Precinct Commander of Prince George's County Police, on January 24, 1996 to discuss the City's Contract Police Contract. Also, Mayor Hanko met with Lt. Buddy Robeshaw the Community Police Officer in charge of the COPS program to discuss a police outpost station in New Carrollton. Mayor Hanko and Lt. Robeshaw toured the City for the purpose of selecting a site. Mayor Hanko recommended that the outpost be placed in one of the following areas: New Carrollton Shopping Center, Carrollton Shopping Plaza 30, Old City Hall or the New Carrollton Library. Lastly, Mayor Hanko announced that Corporal Drummond will be replacing Corporal Thomas Sobolewski as the third Contract Police Officer.

Mayor Hanko announced that the New Carrollton Library will be celebrating its 25th Anniversary the week of March 4 - 9th and this will be publicized in the March City Newsletter.

Mayor Hanko announced that the youth group Colours is performing a musical concert at Charles Carroll Middle School on Friday, February 23, 1996 at 7:00 p.m. The concert is free and residents are invited to attend.

Mayor Hanko announced that the Washington Metropolitan Transit Authority has temporarily rerouted Bus routes 84 and 85 on Carrollton Parkway to the north side. This change will become effective on February 26, 1996. A notice will be televised on Channel B-10 and a letter will be mailed to every household on Carrollton Parkway between Lamont Drive and 85th Place. The City apologizes for the change and the purpose is to measure vibrations caused by traffic.

Mayor Hanko reported that the City will be distributing a City map which is being prepared by Victor Konsavage of the Public Information Solution Company in New Jersey. The map is free of charge and will be included in the Welcome packets.

Lastly, Mayor Hanko reported that the City is in the process of replacing street lights.

Administrative Officer Pierce reported that packets for candidates for the elected positions of Mayor and City Council for the City's upcoming General Election held in May are available at the City Municipal Building. Interested candidates must submit an application in accordance with the published deadline which is printed in the City

Public Works Director Robbins reminded the residents to clear a path to their trash cans during snowy conditions or place the trash cans near the driveway so that all trash can be collected.

Council Member Keleti commented that he has noticed an increase of police presence in the City. Mr. Keleti commented on the City's snow removal policy and stated that courts are not being cleared. Mr. Robbins explained the reason in lengthy detail.

Council Member Hurdle mentioned that tree stumps will be removed once the weather permits.

Council Member Garvey expressed his concern to the bus rerouting schedule on Carrollton Parkway and inquired as to the time period of the test. Mayor Hanko replied that the test will be conducted in an 18 month time period. Discussion ensued with Council Member Garvey stating that it is dangerous for residents to stand near the creek while waiting for the bus. Chairman Schaffer also expressed his concern and concurred with Council Member Garvey. Council Member Garvey requested that this issue be further discussed at the next City Council Workshop Meeting.

Chairman Schaffer stated that the parking lot lights at the New Carrollton Library parking lot are inoperable due to the cold weather and snow. The County will replace the lines as soon as a thaw permits ground digging.

#### 3. **REPORT OF THE TREASURER**

Newsletter.

Alternate Treasurer, Stephen L. Keleti reported 109 invoices totaling \$66,786.06; certified and recommended payment.

Council Member Garvey moved that the Treasurer's Report be approved as presented; with a copy attached to the Minutes.

Council Member Hurdle seconded the motion, without objection, the Treasurer's Report was approved as presented with three in favor and one abstention (Council Member Keleti).

# 4. CONSIDERATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES OF JANUARY 16, 1996

Council Member Hurdle moved that the January 16, 1996 City Council Workshop Minutes be tabled.

Council Member Keleti seconded the motion, and without objection, it was so ordered.

CONSIDERATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF JANUARY 17, 1996

Council Member Hurdle moved that the January 17, 1996 City Council Minutes be approved as presented.

Council Member Keleti seconded the motion, and without objection, the item was passed unanimously.

5. **REPORTS OF THE COUNCIL** 

Council Member Keleti reported the following items:

• Council Member Keleti reported that there will be a New Carrollton Neighborhood Watch Meeting this Saturday at 10:00 a.m. at the City Municipal Building. Mr. Stephen John will be the new Coordinator and thanked Bill Boisvert for running the program the last three years.

Council Member Hurdle reported the following items:

- Council Member Hurdle also thanked Mr. Boisvert for coordinating the program and suggested that Senate Bill #463 pertaining to **unregistered motor vehicles** be discussed at a City Council Workshop Meeting.
- Council Member Hurdle requested that Senate Bill #3 pertaining to Elections sponsored by Senator Miller be discussed at a City Council Workshop Meeting as well as the Video Tax Bill.
- Council Member Hurdle thanked Mr. Nelson Monteith, Mr. Waclo and the Police Review Committee for their involvement and efforts to the City's Street Light Program.
- Council Member Hurdle announced that Cub Scout Pack #1015 will be holding their Blue and Gold Dinner at the City Municipal Building on Saturday, February 10, 1996.

- Council Member Hurdle expressed her sympathy and condolences to Tom and Anna Leslie on the recent loss of their daughter Joyce. Contributions should be forwarded to ARC of Prince George's County at 1300 Mercantile Lane, Suite 200, Springdale Maryland 20774.
- Council Member Hurdle thanked Ms. Kathy Bevard for designing the Library book marker and urged the residents to support and use the Library.
- Council Member Hurdle reported that she attended the West Lanham Fire Departments Annual Banquet and the fire department received 8,935 emergency calls for the year. Mrs. Hurdle encouraged the residents to donate a contribution so that the fire department can purchase new equipment. The banquet was held in honor of Mr. Darrel "Skeeter" Turney.
- Council Member Hurdle reported that she appeared before the Prince George's Delegation to voice a position on zoning matters.
- Lastly, Council Member Hurdle announced that she will be seeking re-election as Council Member to the New Carrollton City Council.

Council Member Garvey had no report.

Chairman Schaffer reported the following items:

- Chairman Schaffer congratulated Mr. Stephen John on his new position as the Coordinator of the Neighborhood Watch Program and thanked Mr. Boisvert for running the program the last three years.
- Chairman Schaffer also expressed his condolences to the Leslie family.
- Chairman Schaffer expressed his concern over the open air drug market at the Heritage Square Apartments and discussed this problem with the manager at Heritage Square. In an effort to combat the drug problem, a meeting has been scheduled so that the City Council, Prince George's County Police Department and the Management of Heritage Square can discuss probable solutions.
- Chairman Schaffer reported that Senate Bill 151 pertaining to a sales tax for school construction sponsored by Senator Leo Green will also be discussed at a City Council Workshop Meeting and Mr. Schaffer expressed his opposition.
- Chairman Schaffer reported that the New Carrollton Library offers residents a chance to use and learn the Internet and terminals at the library at not cost.

• Chairman Schaffer reported that citizens of 60 years of age and older can take classes at the University of Maryland for free with a one time fee of \$116.

Mr. Schaffer stated that his letter would not be read at this time and will be discussed at the next City Council Workshop Meeting with a reply to Mr. Giron's concerns to be developed at that meeting.

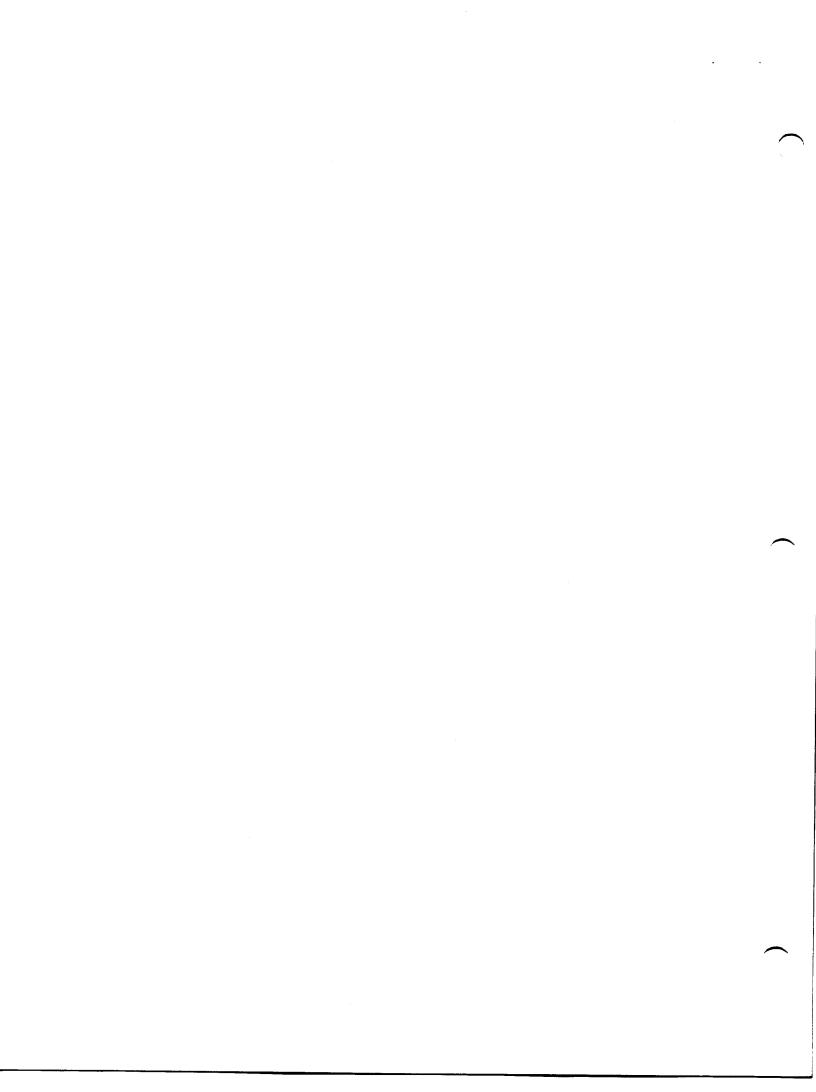
